A GARDEN HAVEN UNFOLDS ON YOSEMITE'S DOORSTEP

Apple Tree Inn Offers Special Rate Packages Beginning in September

Fish Camp, CA—Here amid the pine-studded Sierras, just minutes from the majesties of Yosemite National Park, new natural wonders are unfolding as the Apple Tree Inn treats guests to a growing display of colorful themed gardens—which can be enjoyed with special rate packages beginning in September (see below for details).

The Apple Tree Inn is located on scenic Highway 41 in historic Fish Camp, just two miles from the south gate entrance to Yosemite National Park, and near Bass Lake and Badger Pass Ski Area. Enfolded by the majesty of rolling woodlands, this intimate resort features 54 rooms, including 19 cottages, across six acres. Each room boasts a gas fireplace and other cozy appointments. The peaceful grounds are studded with native ponderosa pines, sugar pines, firs, maples and oaks.

The Apple Tree Inn belongs to Moonstone Hotel Properties, a small family of boutique garden-themed inns in California and Oregon. Moonstone Hotel Properties also owns the Cambria Nursery & Florist in coastal Cambria, California, and manages The Oregon Garden, an 80-acre botanical showcase located 45 minutes south of Portland.

“We are very passionate about treating our guests to fabulous gardens,” Galloway said. “At the Apple Tree Inn, this means incorporating gardens seamlessly into an already beautiful environment.”
